FINAL ORDER

Sh. Sher Singh S/o Late Mangla Ram R/o B-184, DDA Flat, New Ranjeet Nagar, New Delhi-110008 has filed before the Tribunal vide registration no. 78 (5474) dated 15/10/2014 complaining against his sons Sh. Jagdish Chander, Sh. Girdhari Lal, Sh. Mahinder Pal and Sh.



Ravi Kumar under section 5 of the Maintenance & Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

Case called; present Sh Sher Singh (Petitioner) with his three son's i.e. Sh. Girdhari Lal, Sh. Ravi Kumar and Sh. Vijay pal (Respondents). Sh. Sher Singh, Sr. Citizen (whose source of income is only old age pension) has stated that he sold his property in a sum of Rupees sixteen lacs and after distributing among all the children, rest of amount i.e. Rs. Two Lacs left with him which he had given to sh. Ravi Kumar, Respondent. Now, the Respondent Sh. Ravi Kumar refused to return the said amount to the petitioner.

During the conciliation efforts Sh. Ravi Kumar has agreed to return the amount of Rupees Two Lacs in the installment of Rs. 10,000/- per month by submitting in the bank account of Sh. Sher Singh, Sr. Citizen.


After going through the observation and documentary evidences, the Tribunal decides to pass Final Orders as follows:-

1. Sh. Ravi Kumar shall pay the amount of rupees Two Lacs in the installment of Rs. 10,000 per month in the bank account of the petitioner Sh. Sher Singh.
2. All the six respondents (Sh. Jagdish Chander, Sh. Girdhari Lal, Sh. Mahinder Pal, Sh. Ravi Kumar, Sh. Vijay Pal and Sh. Tek Chand) shall pay Rs. 1,500/- per month each to the petitioner through cheque by 10th of every month into the bank account of the Senior Citizen.
3. All the parties are advised to improve their interpersonal relationship and live peacefully among themselves.
