FINAL ORDER

The petitioner Sh. Tarlochan Singh Sethi R/o Janta Flat RG B 293, Raghubir Nagar, New Delhi has filed application before the Tribunal vide registration no. 44 (3671) dated 15/07/2014 complaining against his sons Sh. Iqbal Singh and Sh. Mohinder Pal Singh under section 5 of the Maintenance & Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizens Act, 2007.


Case called. Present Sh. Tarlochan Singh Sethi and no one present on behalf of respondents. The petitioner has claimed for maintenance from his sons as respondents and wanted eviction from the property no. CA 115/2, Tagore Garden, New Delhi-110027 which is already in possession of petitioner's son named Sh. Mohinder Pal and Sh. Mohinder Pal Singh is stated before the Tribunal that he is the legal owner of the said property.

After going through documentary evidences, although the Petitioner, Sh. Tarlochan Singh, has debarred and disowned the Respondent sons from his own property it is bound duty of




the sons to look after their parents when they become old and infirm. The Tribunal decides to pass Final Orders as follows:-

1. Both the respondent sons (Sh. Iqbal Singh and Sh. Mohinder Pal Singh) shall pay Rs. 5,000/- per month equally to the petitioner through cheque by 10<sup>th</sup> of every month into the account of the Senior Citizens.
2. It is advised to maintain good respectful behavior by the respondents towards their old and ailing father Sh. Tarlochan Singh.
3. All parties are advised to improve and maintain their good interpersonal relationship and live peacefully among themselves.
