Case called. Present Smt. Kaushalaya Devi, Petitioner who was complaining against the quarrelsome behavior of her son Sh. Jagdish Kumar and daughter-in-law Smt. Shalu. The petitioner has already filed the case of eviction in Tis Hazari Court and the respondent Smt. Shalu also filed the maintenance case in the same court. Petitioner has not claimed any maintenance from the respondents.
